Supervisor Rebecca Ryan calls the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. at the Warsaw Town Office located at 83 Center Street Warsaw, NY 14569 at which time and place the following were:

Supervisor Ryan opened the Public Hearing for the 2023 Budget. There will be an opportunity for comments

Steve Perkins asked if the Town Clerk received any comments. There were none

A motion was made by Dave Mateer and seconded by Chris Lonneville to enter into executive session at 5:01

A motion was made by Chris Lonneville and seconded by Travis Jones to end executive session at 5:19

There was discussion on Town Clerk Cathy Smith asking to be paid something for tax collection. Ms. Smith noted that it was a separate job in itself. Cathy Smith asked when were the positions combined as there is no documentation. Supervisor Ryan noted that there would be no pay for collecting taxes as it has always been that way even when Abby Hyland was Town Clerk.

Supervisor Ryan pulled out the budget sheet completed by Town Clerk Cathy Smith. I requested Registrar fees as it is something I am entitled to even though I have not requested it in the past and it does not amount to much money. It has never been about the money and it is a law and should be payable separate from the Town Clerk pay. I answered that it was time to think about myself

Travis Jones asked me why was I just now requesting. I answered that I have always thought of the tax payers and I work hard to make sure the requested documents go to the person entitled, it protects the town and myself and it is the law. It was asked why I didn't provide them with the law prior. Cathy Smith answered that she did provide it to Becky in August. Copies with response from the Association of Towns email were made and given to the board members. I also noted that this was not my first time inquiring directly with the Association of Towns.

Dave Mateer noted that the Town Clerk was not the Registrar. Supervisor Ryan commented that I was appointed to that position at the Organizational meeting.

Supervisor Ryan stated that what I had submitted to her in August does not read the same as the email. Cathy Smith said to disregard the budget sheet and use what was provided by the Association of Towns. The Board felt that more time was needed to read the email from the Association of Towns as it was said that it may not be the law.

A motion was made by Steve Perkins and seconded by Travis Jones to leave the Public Hearing open until the November 09, 2022 meeting. Ayes: 5, Nays: 0, AIF
