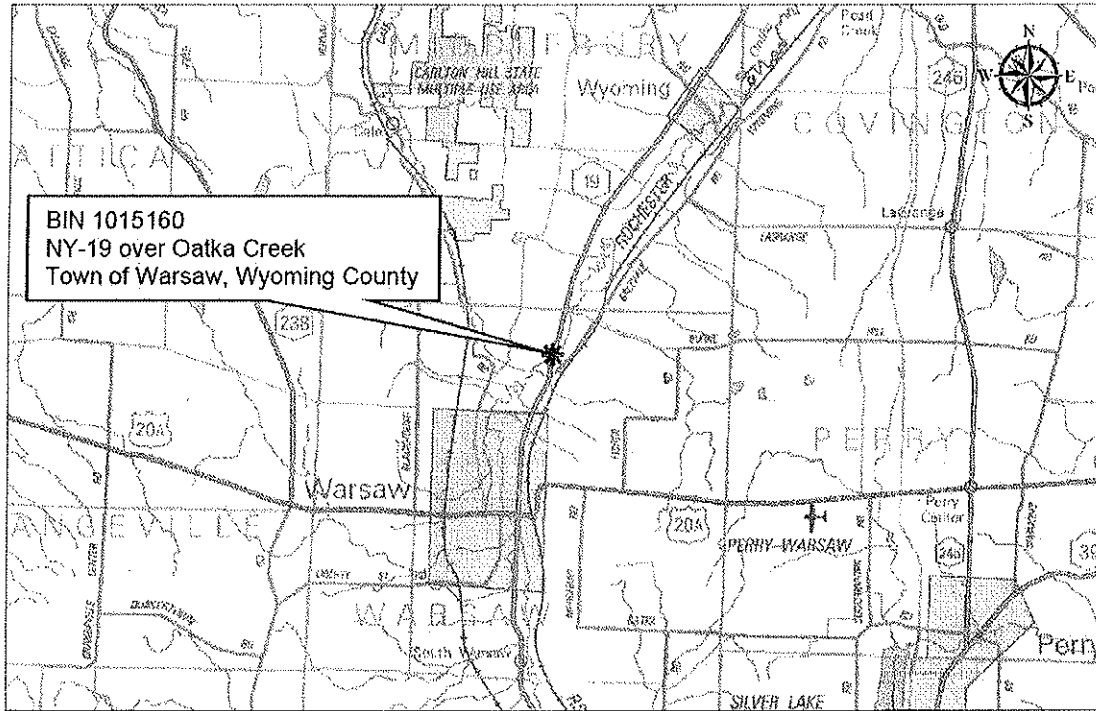

On behalf of the New York State Department of Transportation, Concrete Applied Technologies Corp. dba CATCO will begin to replace the bridge carrying NY-19 over Oatka Creek in the Town of Warsaw, Wyoming County on or about 02/28/2022. The bridge will be closed for up to 180 calendar days and will re-open before Labor Day weekend 2022.

Vehicular traffic will follow a detour utilizing Saltvale Road. The truck detour will utilize NY-63, NY-36, NY-39/20A and NY-19A (approximately 30-miles). Local traffic will have access to NY-19 on both sides of the bridge up to the construction zone.

Motorists will be kept informed with variable message signs and temporary work zone traffic control signs on site. Real-time traffic and construction updates can also be found by visiting www.511ny.org.

Project Overview:

Project Schedule:

- Construction in 2022

WZTC:

- NY-19 will be completely closed to traffic at Oatka Creek
- Local traffic will be allowed access up to the construction zone on both sides of the bridge
- Vehicular traffic will be detoured utilizing Saltvale Road
- Truck traffic will be detoured utilizing NY-63, NY-36, NY-39/20A, and NY-19A (an approximate 30-mile detour)
- Contract provisions will require:
 - the bridge be closed no more than 180 days
 - the bridge be opened prior to Labor Day weekend 2022
