TOWN OF WARSAW WATER DISTRICT UPDATES – APRIL 1, 2024

Dear Town of Warsaw Water District Customer,

We would like to provide you with a couple of updates that have recently happened regarding the Town of Warsaw Water District (Town).

Late last fall, the Town posted a Request for Qualifications/Proposals to provide engineering services for a complete review of the Town's Water District, establish a plan to address deficiencies noted and to apply for funding opportunities to help offset the costs associated with those updates. Seven firms submitted proposals to the Town for consideration, after reviewing each of them, interviewing three of the firms, we have retained Clark Patterson Lee (CPL) Engineering, Rochester, NY. Jason Foote, P.E., with CPL, has started working on this project and we will provide updates as the process unfolds.

The Town is currently participating, with the Wyoming County Water Resource Agency, in a grant funding opportunity to replace the current aged water meters currently used in the town with new electronic reading Neptune water meters. This funding is being provided by a NYS Department of State Local Efficiency Grant and will pay a large portion of the costs associated with the purchase and replacement of the water meters. After bidding the installation portion of the project and receiving three bids, the Town accepted the low bid for the meter installation from DS Plumbing Heating & Cooling (Dave Stock), Strykersville, NY. This process is scheduled to start this month. We are asking the customers to contact Dave to start scheduling these replacements at the phone number and/or email shown below.
